

Eligibility Criteria suggested

- 1. Open to B.Tech students from all streams currently enrolled in year 4.**
- 2. Student should not be receiving any scholarships from NITK, State and Central Govt, Alumni Office and any other Philanthropic organisations.**
- 3. 60% weightage for academics and 30 % for Extracurricular activities (Multiple activities will not be mutually exclusive but additive. Eg. If a student has represented college in sports, debate and presented a paper , he or she will be eligible for adding scores in each activity subject a maximum of 30%) (Please refer to evaluation Forms)**
- 4. 10% weighting - Letter of recommendation from HoD for being an outstanding student, either in a subject, stream or character. To be received in a sealed envelope to be opened by evaluators. HoD is free to assign a score between 0 and 10**

It is our intention to distribute the awards to five different streams of Rs 26000 each, with no particular stream preference. Excellence criteria will be paramount.

Students to prepare 1 additional page with the information with how you comply to the criteria above with copies of evidence apart from filling the evaluation form properly.
